Installation Method 1: Setup Wizard (Recommended)

The Setup Wizard provides a streamlined installation experience with automatic configuration and immediate protection activation:

Step-by-Step Installation Process

- Visit the official download page
- Click the Download button to get the latest version
- Save the file to a location you can easily find (typically Downloads folder)
- Open your Downloads folder or the location where you saved the file
- Look for the file named gsam-en-install.exe
- If you can't find your downloaded files, refer to Microsoft's guide for locating downloads
- Double-click the gsam-en-install.exe file
- If Windows SmartScreen appears, click "More info" and then "Run anyway"
- Wait for the installer to initialize
- When the User Account Control (UAC) prompt appears, click Yes
- This permission is required for proper installation and security functionality
- If you don't have administrator rights, contact your system administrator
- The wizard will automatically download and install the latest program files
- Progress will be displayed during the installation process
- If prompted to restart your computer, save all work and click Restart Now
- The installer will automatically resume after the restart
- Automatic Updates: Downloads the most current version during installation
- Optimized Settings: Configures default settings for immediate protection
- Minimal User Input: Requires fewer decisions during installation
- Quick Setup: Faster installation process for most users

Installation Method 2: Full Installation Package

The full installation package provides more control over the installation process and works better in environments with limited internet connectivity:

Full Installer Process

- Navigate to the full installer download page
- Download the complete installation package
- This file contains all necessary components for offline installation
- Double-click the downloaded installation file
- Grant administrator permissions when prompted
- Wait for the installer to start
- Choose your preferred language from the dropdown menu
- This will be used for the installation process and software interface
- Click Next to continue
- Read the welcome message and installation notes
- Click Next to proceed to the license agreement
- Carefully read the End User License Agreement (EULA)
- Click I Agree to accept the terms and continue
- You must accept the agreement to proceed with installation
- Select the destination folder for Gridinsoft Anti-Malware
- The default location (C:\Program Files\Gridinsoft Anti-Malware) is recommended
- Click Browse to choose a different location if needed
- Ensure the selected drive has sufficient free space
- Review your installation choices
- Click Install to start copying files
- Monitor the progress bar during file installation
- Wait for all files to be installed and configured
- Click Finish when installation completes
- Choose whether to launch the program immediately
- Offline Installation: Can be installed without internet connection
- Custom Location: Allows selection of installation directory

- Network Deployment: Suitable for installing on multiple computers
- Complete Package: Includes all components in a single download

Common Installation Problems

- Slow Download: Check your internet connection speed and retry
- Incomplete Download: Clear browser cache and download again
- Blocked Download: Temporarily disable browser security extensions
- Corrupted File: Re-download from the official website
- Permission Errors: Ensure you're logged in as an administrator
- Antivirus Interference: Temporarily disable other security software
- Insufficient Space: Free up disk space and retry installation
- Windows Updates: Install pending Windows updates before trying again
- Older Windows: Verify your OS version meets minimum requirements
- 32-bit Systems: Ensure you downloaded the correct architecture version
- Virtual Machines: Some features may require additional configuration
- Corporate Networks: Check with IT department about installation policies

If installation problems persist, try running the installer in compatibility mode for an older Windows version, or contact Gridinsoft support with details about the error messages you're receiving.
