

How To Uninstall Trojan Killer

You can remove Trojan Killer in a few clicks. Choose the method that fits your setup.

Method 1 - Windows Settings (Windows 10/11)

- Open Settings -> Apps -> Installed apps (Win 11) or Apps & features (Win 10).
- Find Trojan Killer -> Uninstall -> confirm.

Method 2 - Control Panel (all supported Windows)

- Open Control Panel -> Programs -> Programs and Features.
- Select Trojan Killer -> Uninstall/Change -> confirm.

Portable Edition (no installation)

If you used the Portable Edition, there's nothing to "uninstall."

- Close the app, then delete the Trojan Killer folder from your USB drive (or wherever you unpacked it).
- If you created logs or quarantine on that drive, delete those folders too.

If uninstall is blocked

- Close the app first: Right-click the Trojan Killer icon in the system tray -> Exit.
- Reboot and try again: Some components finish removal after a restart.
- Temporarily pause other security tools: EDR/AV may block uninstallers. Re-enable afterward.
- Safe Mode (last resort): Reboot to Safe Mode, then run Method 1 or 2.
