

Will scans slow down my PC?

Scans use CPU and disk I/O, so you may notice slower performance-especially during a Full scan. To minimize impact, run Quick scans during the day and schedule Full scans for off-hours. You can also pause heavy tasks while scanning, use Custom scan to target only needed folders/drives, and exclude large, trusted archives or backups. On laptops, keep the device plugged in to avoid throttling. If performance still dips, run scans when you're away from the keyboard.
